Dear Pfizer Retiree:

This letter and the enclosed attachments include information about the move to a Medicare Part D prescription drug plan.

As communicated in January 2015, prescription drug coverage for Pfizer Medicare-eligible retirees and their Medicare-eligible dependents will move to **SilverScript Employer PDP sponsored by Pfizer (SilverScript)** effective Jan. 1, 2016. SilverScript is a Pfizer-sponsored Medicare Part D prescription drug plan offered through SilverScript<sup>®</sup> Insurance Company which is affiliated with CVS/caremark<sup>™</sup>, Pfizer's current pharmacy benefit manager.

**With the switch to SilverScript, your prescription drug coinsurance percentage and per-prescription minimum and maximum will not change in 2016. Additionally, your coverage will continue to include 100% coverage for Pfizer drugs including Greenstone generic drugs.**

Included with this letter is an overview of the 2016 Pfizer prescription drug coverage for Medicare-eligible retirees, as well as a timeline and additional FAQs about SilverScript. The timeline lists the materials you will receive during the 2016 Annual Enrollment period, including information on retiree webinars about SilverScript.
